- **Material of gloves**  
The selection of the suitable gloves does not only depend on the material, but also on further marks of quality and varies from manufacturer to manufacturer. As the product is a preparation of several substances, the resistance of the glove material can not be calculated in advance and has therefore to be checked prior to the application.

Urea will never be inhaled because it is never evaporated or spewed as powder from the product in the normal state of use.  
Therefore, we have classified the product out of the respiratory sensitization class.
