## **Notice Concerning Start of Operations at Ariake Plant**

Harmonic Drive Systems Inc. is pleased to announce the start of operations at its new plant acquired in December 2017. Details are set out below.

As announced in the November 9, 2017 press release headed "Announcing Plant Property Acquisition in Nagano," in December 2017 the Company acquired a plant property (the Ariake Plant) located in Azumino City, Nagano Prefecture and is moving forward with plans to sharply raise production capacity for its HarmonicDrive® devices.

There are two existing plant buildings at the Ariake Plant, and with the completion of upgrading work on Building No. 1, operations began in March as initially planned. Upgrading of the remaining building is scheduled for completion at the end of August 2018. The Company is also proceeding with plans to construct a new plant building on the same site.

Focusing on the primary applications of the Company's products, which include industrial robots, semiconductor manufacturing equipment, and flat-panel display manufacturing systems, in conjunction with the Hotaka Plant, which is currently a core base for domestic HarmonicDrive® production capacity, systems are being put in place to raise monthly production to 200,000 devices by March 2021.
